Housing many forms of tourism from coastal tourism to thermal tourism, and from culture tourism to nature tourism, the province welcomes the tourists throughout the year.

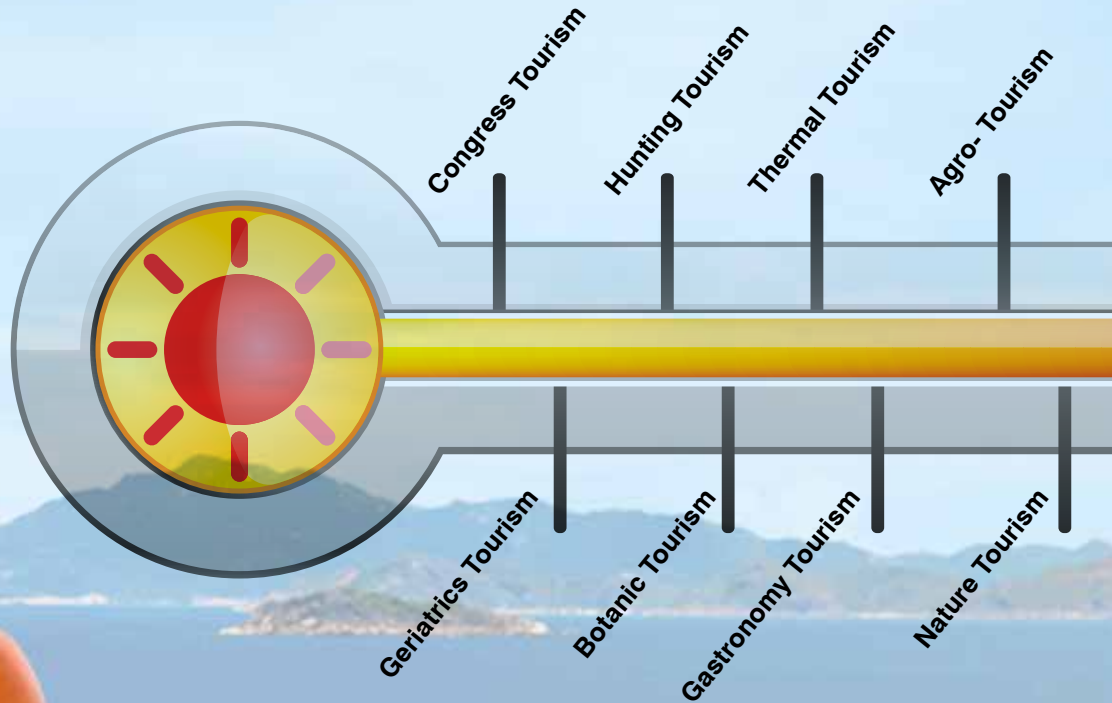




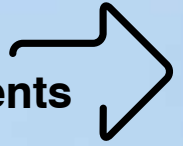
First Address of Tourism Investments

The province hosts many different tourism activities in line with its goal of “uninterrupted tourism throughout the year” along with its developing coastal tourism, enabled by its geographic location.

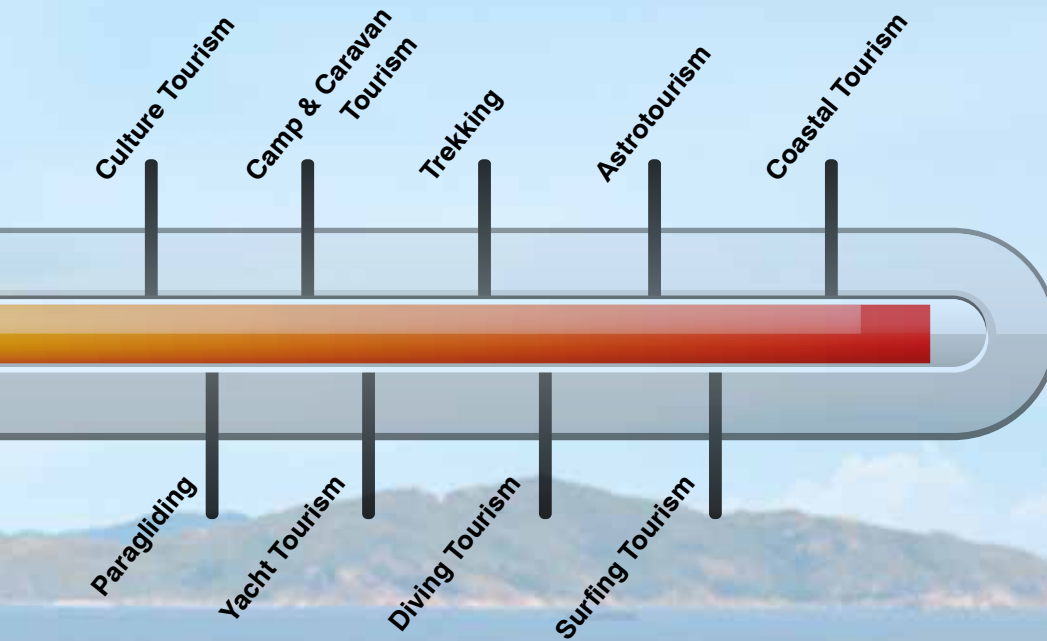


First Address of Tourism Investments

23 Blue Flag Beaches

Having a shore of 291 km on Marmara and Aegean Seas, Balıkesir has a developed tourism industry in Ayvalık, Gömeç, Burhaniye, Edremit, Erdek and Marmara Island.

Ayvalık has a strong coastal tourism and 7 km long and 100 m wide Sarımsaklı beach and Altınova beaches add to the attraction of the province in summers.

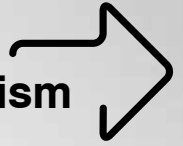
Increasing population with Coastal Tourism active in summers

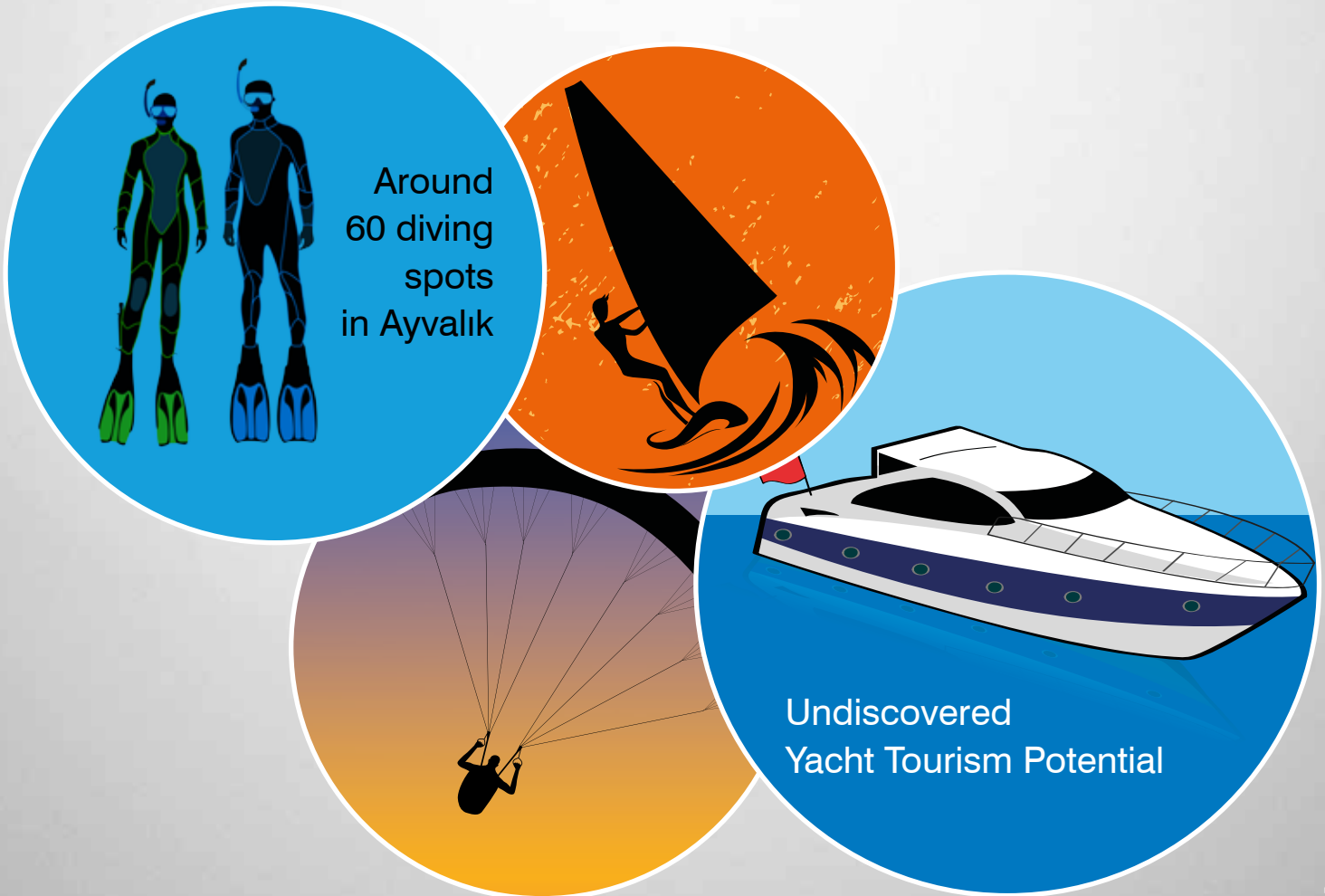


Rich Alternative Tourism Supported by Coastal Tourism



Ayvalık Islands, Edremit Bay and Marmara Islands are tourist hotspots with their unique coves and bays suitable for diving, paragliding and surfing.

Yacht tourism is especially common in Ayvalık-Burhaniye line. A blue flagged marina and yacht yard serves in Ayvalık. Additionally, marina in Burhaniye is a treasure awaiting discovery for yacht tourism.





The Right Address for Thermal Tourism Investments

Thermal tourism is a kind of tourism that is carried out in touristic locations with healing waters and that meets the accommodation, resting and recreation needs of people for the purpose of treating some diseases and protecting health.

Waters from geothermal sources with high flow rate and temperature are healing waters that have curative effects verified by tests and analysis conducted in accredited laboratories.

Balikesir is the province with the most thermal tourism centers in Turkey. There are 8 different thermal tourism centers in the province.

Declared Tourism Centers

Culture Tourism Protection and Development Regions (KTKGB) and Tourism Centers (TM) are areas declared by the Cabinet for the protection and development of areas that have touristic value. Bureaucratic processes are eased in these areas for touristic facility investments enabling quick realization of investments. By preventing elements that are harmful to tourism in these regions touristic investments in such regions have the convenience of being able to operate without the impact of negative factors such as industrial pollution in the long run. Tourism investments made in KTKGBs benefits from “Region 5” incentives in the “6-region incentive system” of the Ministry of Economy.

An area above 28,160 hectares in Erdek, Avşa, Paşalimanı and Ekinlik in Balıkesir province are within KTKGB borders.

Rich Historical and Cultural Heritage



Balıkesir is a center of attraction in culture tourism with its monasteries, museums and ancient cities. Housing many ancient cities such as Antandros, Daskyleion, Kyzikos and Adramytteion, the province has rapidly increasing excavations and restoration works in cooperation with Ministry of Tourism and Culture and universities.

Balıkesir hosts a great treasure of historical and cultural heritage; Ancient Greece, Rome, Byzantium, Seljuk and Ottoman Empire. 10 museums serve to promote and introduce the handcrafts and historical social structure prominent in these ages, along with a great number of historical buildings.

Topographic features of The Mount Ida in Balıkesir, make it a center of attraction for tourists interested in trekking activities. Yayla Hill and Ayı Stream in the Mount Ida are significant stops while Sındırgı, Dursunbey, İvrindi, Edremit, Ayvalık, Erdek and Susurluk host trekking organizations.

Jeep Safari

Developing under favorable geographic features, jeep safari tours make the province a favored stop for nature lovers. Especially the Mount Ida area is highly sought area for jeep safari tours.

Bird Watching

With its diverse species Bird Sanctuary National Park in Manyas is the number one spot for bird watchers in Turkey. National Park houses many wild birds, especially water birds. Additionally, thanks to the immense number of wild birds they naturally host, Gönen and Edremit have a good potential for bird watching activities.

Agro-Tourism

Being a city of agriculture, Balıkesir has a strong potential for agro-tourism activities. Ayvalık, Burhaniye, Gömeç, Havran and Edremit are the centers where agro-tourism flourish with their rural landscape, natural beauties and alternative tourism areas.

Botanic Trips

Balıkesir is a significant center of attraction for those interested in botanics with the rich flora and endemic plant species it accommodates. Edremit, Erdek, Marmara, Susurluk, Dursunbey and Bigadiç are major centers for botanic trips.

Hunting Tourism

Recreational fishing is developed in Ayvalık, Burhaniye, Edremit, Bandırma and Marmara Island while hunting is developed in inland areas of Balıkesir and in Dursunbey.

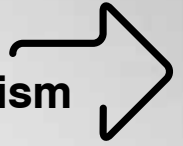
Geriatrics Tourism

Also known as advanced age tourism, geriatrics tourism includes elderly care services, engagement tours, trips and special care for persons with disabilities.

Balıkesir is prominent in geriatrics tourism with its curing thermal sources. Geriatrics tourism is especially prominent in Gönen, Edremit, Sındırgı and Bigadiç counties with their hot springs with appropriate flow rates and temperatures as well as their healing physical and chemical compounds. Additionally, skirts of the Mount Ida are among the ideal locations for health tourism with their fresh air and microclimatic properties.

Tourist's Choice for Diving Sports: Ayvalık

22 islands in Ayvalık enable formation of many bays in the coast. Şeytan Sofrası (Devil's Table) hill is an important vantage point to view the sea, the bays and the islands.

For diving, Ayvalık is a unique spot. Home to numerous fish and marine species as well as its colourful corals Ayvalık is an attraction for diving enthusiasts. The most favored diving locations are Kız Island, Güneş Island, Yuvarlak Island and Kerbela Stones.

Rich Biodiversity: “The Mount Ida National Park”

Separating Aegean and Marmara Regions, the Mount Ida is also the highest mountain of Biga Peninsula.

Deep valleys and canyons of the Mount Ida is a must see nature tourism center with its rich flora and fauna. Şahinderesi Canyon in the area is a favourite of nature lovers with its geographical formations.

Declared a national park in 1994, the region spreads over 22,000 hectares and houses natural beauties in green and blue with 31 endemic species. Touristic area, where hunting is illegal, has a rich biodiversity in wildlife.

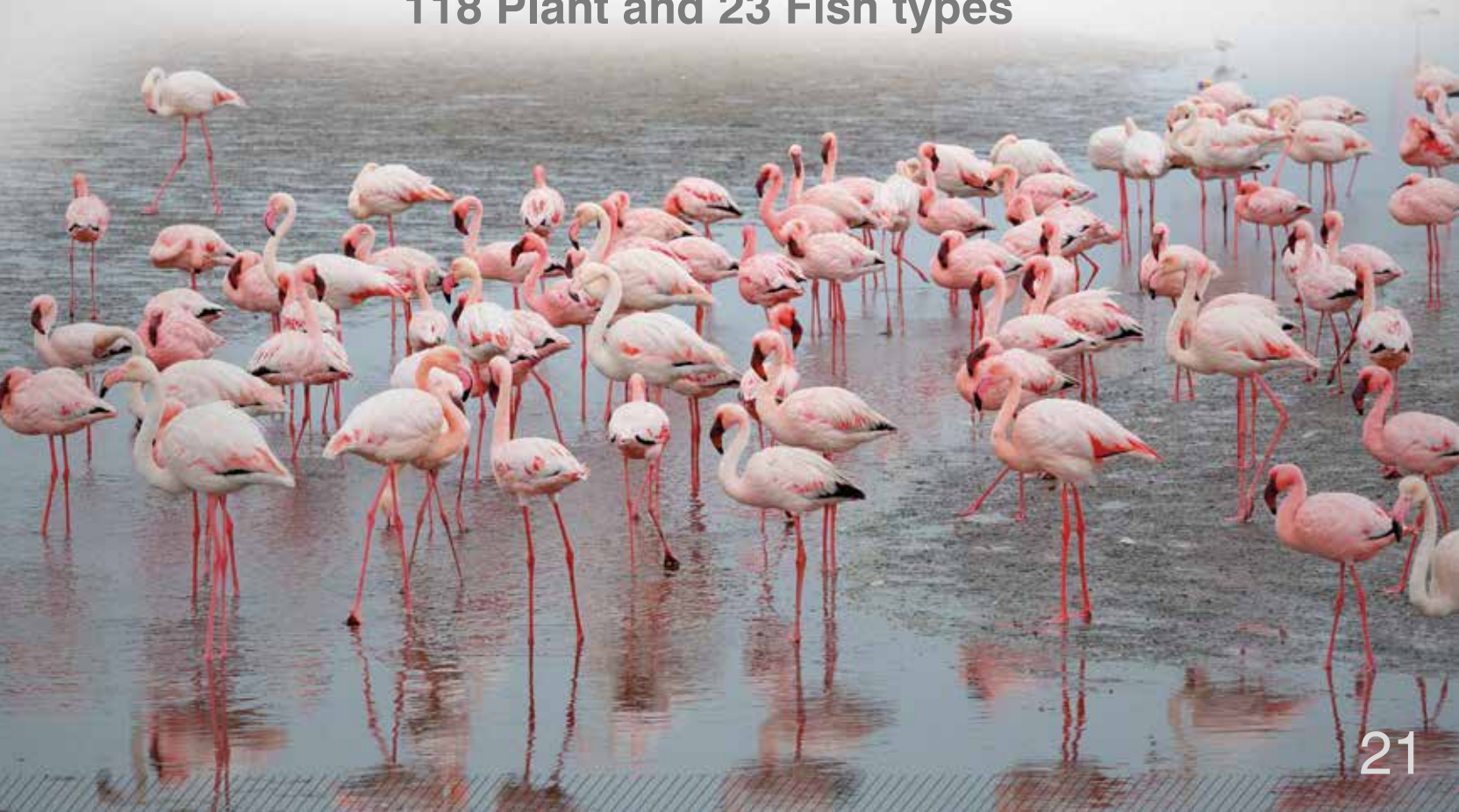
Bird Sanctuary National Park covers an area of over 17,000 hectares and has been declared a national park in 1959 due to its biodiversity (118 plant and 23 fish types) and especially 266 different bird species it houses. Located on the migration routes of birds, the national park has huge breeding colonies, where birds such as pelicans, kingfisher, spoonbill, cormorant, wild goose, wild duck and other passerines nestle in trees and reeds.

Climate Conditions Allowing Four Seasons Tourism in Balıkesir

Balıkesir has shores both on the Aegean and the Marmara Sea. Three different climates can be observed in the province. Mediterranean climate is generally observed in Aegean coast. Temperature difference between summer and winter is generally not felt extensively. Northern counties of the province are under the influence of Marmara Sea, resulting in relatively cooler summers. Interiors of the province are subject to continental climate.

Annual average temperature of Balıkesir is 14.5°C. The province experiences the hottest temperature in July with average 24.2°C and coldest in January with 4.7°C.

These values shows that province has mild climate conditions and climate diversity with mild climate structure enable non-stop tourism activities for 12 months a year.

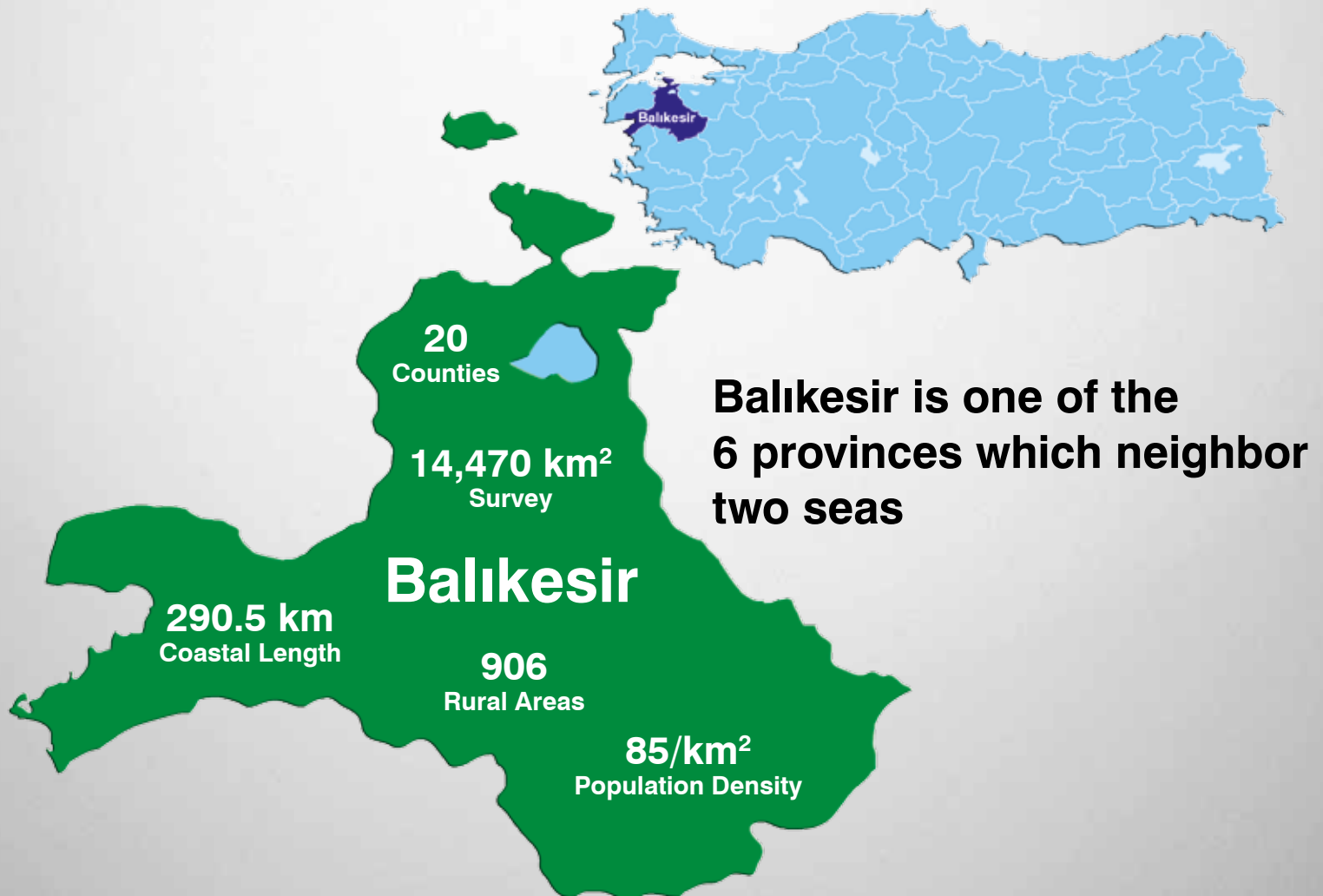




Geographic Location

Located in the south of Marmara Region, Balıkesir is renowned for its proximity to metropolises such as İstanbul, İzmir and Bursa. It is directly linked to all port cities of Turkey through Bandırma Port, which makes it the crossroads between Turkey and World markets.

The “4-Hour Transportation Ring”, which will make Balıkesir a Logistics center, will enable traveling around the Marmara Sea in 4 hours; integrate with new transportation projects and together with the BALO project, will facilitate Balıkesir’s open up to Europe.

Grand Transportation Projects Connected to Balıkesir

► Gebze-Orhangazi-İzmir Highway - Osmangazi Bridge

The highway decreased travel time between İstanbul and İzmir to 3.5 hours and is 433 km long. With Balıkesir located in the center, the completion of the project decreased İstanbul-Balıkesir to 2 hours and İzmir and Balıkesir to 1.5 hours. 2,682 meter long Osmangazi Bridge has a central span of 1,550 meters and is the 4th bridge with largest central span around the world. Entire highway is operational since August 2019.

► Tekirdağ-Çanakkale-Balıkesir Highway Project - 1915 Çanakkale Bridge

This project will create routes alternative to Bosphorus crossing for transportation from Aegean and Inner Anatolia Regions to Thrace and Europe.

Connection of Tekirdağ-Çanakkale-Balıkesir Highway to Gebze-İzmir Highway near Balıkesir will create an additional momentum for tourism and other sectors.

► Bandırma-Balıkesir - İzmir High Speed Train Project

The project will act as the passenger and cargo line connecting Aegean Region to Europe through Bandırma and Tekirdağ ports. It will also connect to Ankara-İstanbul route on Bursa connection.

► Northern Marmara Highway - Yavuz Sultan Selim Bridge

Widest suspended bridge of the world with its 59 meters width and the longest bridge with rail transport on the world with its 1,408 meters of main span.

► Bandırma-Bursa-Bilecik High Speed Train Line Project

With the completion of the 215 km project, Bandırma will be connected to Bursa, which is a metropolis with a fully developed industry, through railroad.

► Tekirdağ-Çanakkale-Bandırma Road Project

Railroad project that will serve passenger and cargo transport between Bandırma and Çanakkale will start from Bandırma and reach Tekirdağ through Çanakkale, over Biga and Karabiga, covering Bandırma Organized Industrial Zone and Gönen Organized Industrial Zone.

► Bay Light Rail System Project

With this project planned between Altınova and Küçükkuyu, a comfortable and rapid transportation will be provided at Bay Line that has a high tourism potential.

Incentives

**The most advantageous incentive region among
the provinces neighboring the Aegean or the Marmara Seas**

Ministry of Industry and Technology



Ministry of Industry and Technology provides incentives for investments in order to reduce regional development differences, increase value added investments, improve production and employment figures, and expand R&D efforts which increase international competitive power.

REGIONAL INCENTIVE PRACTICES

► Customs Tax Exemption

Machinery and equipment to be imported for the investment which will benefit from this incentive are exempt to customs tax.

► VAT Exemption

Machinery and equipment to be purchased for the investment which will benefit from this incentive are exempt from VAT.

► Insurance Premium Employer Share Support

Insurance premium employer share accrued as a result of additional employment created within the scope of the investment is paid by the Ministry; not to exceed minimum wage at the time per employee.

► Tax Reduction

In investments subject to incentives, income and corporate tax are paid with reductions at rates stipulated separately for regions the investment is made in.

► Investment Site Allocation

In investments realized with incentive certificates, free site allocation can be made in order to hasten the investment in some cases.

► Interest Support

In investment loans with at least one year maturity to be used within the scope of regional investment incentive, interest reduction support is provided.

Balıkesir is region-3 in regional investment incentives while thermal tourism facilities are considered region 5. Touristic accommodation investments made in KTKGB areas of Erdek, Avşa, Paşalimanı and Ekinlik are considered region 5.



Agriculture and Rural Development Support Institution (TKDK)

Agriculture and Rural Development Support Institution provides non-repayable grants for hostels, “bed & breakfast” facilities and restaurant services, establishment and development of farm tourism facilities, facilities built for touristic recreational facilities (such as sport activities, nature trips, hobby gardens, riding, mountaineering, biking path, fishing, etc.) established by micro entrepreneurs or farmers within scope of Rural Tourism Program.

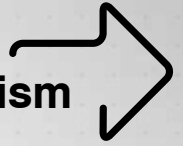


Development Bank of Turkey

Development Bank of Turkey provides medium and long term credits to joint stock companies to direct them to development oriented investments, to ensure profitability and efficiency of the business, to improve partnership structures and to help improve capital markets.



Supports under the Law for Encouragement of Tourism



► Allocation of Entailed Lands and Forest Areas to Tourism Investments

Under the Law for the Encouragement of Tourism, lands in Culture and Tourism Protection Areas and Tourism Centers are allocated to investors by Ministry of Culture and Tourism for a payment of lands' market value.

► Installments to Forestry Fund Participation Fee

The fee which facilities built in forest areas with tourism investment licenses have to pay under the provisions of Forestry Law is paid by the state; starting in the third year of the allocation of the land, in a five years term in five equal installments.

► Discounts in Electricity, Coal Gas and Utility Prices

Investors with tourism investment or business license can pay their electricity, gas and water fees at the lowest rate applied to industrial and domestic subscribers at the region.

► Communication Benefits

Each application for telephone and telex for the businesses with tourism license have priority over other applications.

► Foreign National Employment Permit

Tourism businesses can employ foreign nationals with permit from Ministry of Labor and Social Security limited with up to 10% of the total employees of the business.

► Official Holidays, Weekend and Lunch Break

Tourism businesses can continue to operate in official holidays, weekends and lunch breaks without need for any permit.

► Tourism Credits

Development Bank of Turkey, can provide credit support for investments in culture and tourism protection development regions and tourism centers from foreign resources.

Various trainings are provided under supervision of qualified trainers in line with the needs of the enterprises operating in Balikesir.



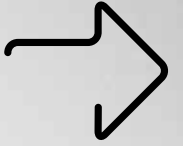
Investments Followed Centrally
